Your support echoes a powerful real-life story that sparked the genesis of Grace Resource Ministries (GRM), one that remains close to my heart.



Bridging the Healthcare Disparity Gap

It all started with an elderly patient during my tenure as a bedside nurse. Her readmission due to heart failure exacerbation merely two weeks after discharge was perplexing. When she disclosed the reason for not filling her prescription—her inability to afford both food and medications—saying, 'I had to choose between food and medications,' it struck a chord in me, compelling the birth of GRM.

Since our inception in 2021, GRM, now a 501c3 nonprofit, has fervently pursued its vision of *to end healthcare disparities, reduce rehospitalizations, and lower mortality rates among the marginalized populations through FREE health education, facilities, and resources.*

Our Progress

Despite the challenges imposed by COVID-19 restrictions, we adapted. We initiated virtual meetings, where medical experts educated the public and addressed their queries. In 2022, we initiated international missions with your support, allowing us to visit and distribute COVID supplies to vulnerable communities. Our inaugural health fair in downtown Raleigh, orchestrated through partnerships with entities like City of Raleigh, Campbell University, Wake County Health and Human Services, NeighborHealth Clinic, and El Centrol Hispano, we provided medical assessments, care and education, facilitated connections for over 50 individuals to primary health care and health resources. Additionally, we offered translation services and provided meals to all attendees.

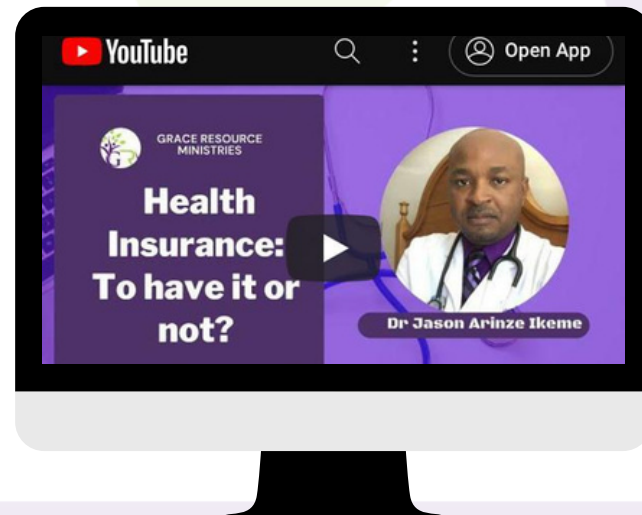
The subsequent year saw a tripling of our partnerships and active participation in six other community events, including Wake Community Day, Myeloma Link Community Day, Women Health Awareness Day, and Apex Earth Day. This remarkable journey has been made possible by the tireless dedication and the support from incredible individuals like yourself.

To date, we've hosted more than 15 LIVE Zoom events and two successful health fair events in Raleigh. Despite facing several challenges, including unrealized health fair plans in Dover and Winston-Salem, and slower-than-expected progress in our online programs, we have persevered. Thanks to your generous donations, we've successfully acquired some essential office equipment and secured professional services for bookkeeping/financial management and social media support.
